We do NOT accept surplus or expired pharmaceuticals, needles/sharps, flares, fireworks, expired fire extinguishers, propane, paint, chemicals, etc. Please contact the San Luis Obispo County Integrated Waste Management Authority. They provide residents of San Luis Obispo County with 5 locations to properly dispose their Household Hazardous Waste for free.
