



Summary

- Payrolls in the City of San Luis Obispo grew 4.5% from the fourth quarter of 2020 to the fourth quarter of 2021, trailing the 6.3% growth in the balance of the State.
- Wages in the City of San Luis Obispo have also increased over the last year, with the average annual wage across all sectors growing by 1.9%, trailing the 4.7% pace in the balance of the State.
- The Transportation, Warehousing, and Utilities sector (43.7%), Leisure and Hospitality sector (28.5%), and Other Services sector (24.9%) led industry level job growth during this time period.
- Over the last year, the Manufacturing and Administrative Support sectors also added a significant number of new jobs in the City of San Luis Obispo.
- At the subsector level, Beverage and Tobacco Product Manufacturing; Amusements, Gambling, and Recreation; and Health and Membership Associations and Organizations led job growth from the fourth quarter of 2020 to the fourth quarter of 2021.
- Over the last year, wage growth in the Transportation, Warehousing, and Utilities; Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services and Management; and Leisure and Hospitality sectors led the way in the City of San Luis Obispo.
- Job growth continues for small firms in the City of San Luis Obispo. While already accounting for the majority of jobs in the city, small firms growing by 3.3% over the last year, outpacing growth for mid-size firms (-1.7%) and large firms (0.3%).




