

INFORMAL DISCOVERIES

Pursuant to California Penal Code §1054.5, informal requests for discovery by a defendant can be made prior to obtaining a court order.

- Requests for discovery in **felony** and **misdemeanor** cases should be made through the San Luis Obispo District Attorney's Office as their office is the prosecuting attorney.
- Requests for discovery in **infraction** cases should be made through the San Luis Obispo Police Department since the District Attorney's office does not prosecute infraction cases. The issuing Agency is considered the "prosecuting attorney".
- Please note that **administrative citations** are **not criminal** and therefore an informal discovery request does not apply. When contesting your administrative citation, you will receive a packet from Neighborhood Outreach which will include a copy of the citation, including the officer's notes at no cost. This packet contains all the information that the hearing officer will have access to at your hearing.

Requests need to be made in writing. You may use the Informal Discovery Request form which is available at the Records counter or by printing page three of this document, however it is not mandatory to use this form. Please make sure to be specific regarding what items you are requesting. In addition, you will need to provide a legible photocopy of your ID (Driver's License or passport). A copy can be made by Records staff if you drop your request off in person during regular business hours.

The Records Supervisor will contact you within 15 days, once research has been done to determine what requested materials we have, and what the fee will be to obtain them.

Please be sure to include a phone number or email address where you can be reached in case clarification of what you're asking for is necessary.

If you have any additional questions that were not addressed here, please contact the San Luis Obispo Police Department and ask for the Records Supervisor.
