Welcome to the City of San Luis Obispo! Over the past several years we have been working to provide your area with a plan for urban services such as water, sewer, street maintenance, policing and firefighting. On November 16th, 2011 the annexation became official - you are now a part of the City and eligible to receive many of these services.

All of the normal functions of local government such as building permits, building inspections, and development review are now provided to you by the City. Any permits previously issued by the County will be finalized by the County to ensure a smooth transition. As with all neighborhoods in the City, we are working hard to provide you with a secure and excellent water supply and an effectively managed sewer system. City staff are available to help you take advantage of these services when you are ready. If you are already receiving City water and sewer services you may now be entitled to lower in-City utilities rates. For your convenience I have attached a list of City contact numbers.

As City residents, you are represented by five City Council members, including myself, Mayor Jan Howell Marx, Vice Mayor Dan Carpenter, John Ashbaugh, Andrew Carter, and Kathy Smith. The Council is supported by numerous volunteer citizen advisory bodies, including the Planning Commission, Architectural Review Commission, and Cultural Heritage Committee.
